Soup KITCHENS



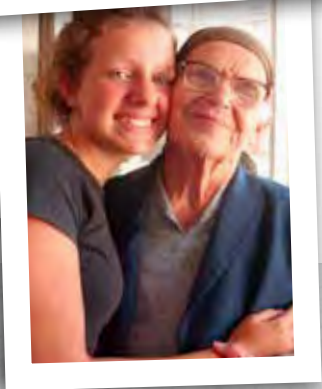
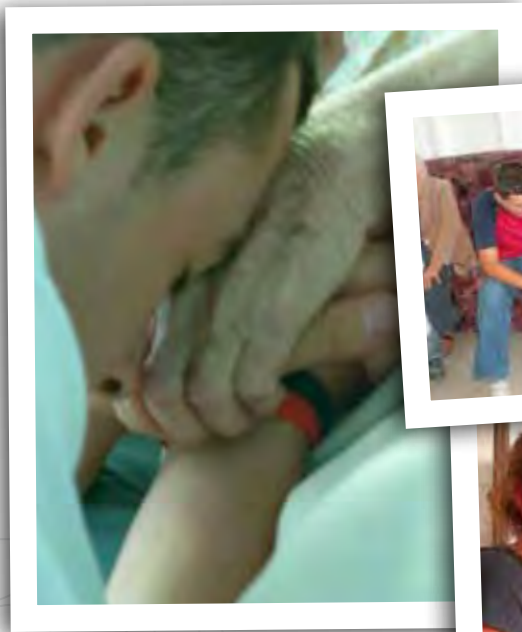

Community CENTRES

You will receive a **multi-faceted overview** of Mission Without Borders' work in Moldova and Ukraine that is carried out in cooperation with the Local Church, in our Crihana Veche and Sarny Community Centres. Activities on the premises include soup kitchens, vocational/educational courses (such as English, computer literacy, tailoring and cooking) and a variety of other social services.

Your involvement at the Community Centre will consist of **preparing** food, **servicing/delivering** meals while at the same time having the chance to **dialogue** with beneficiaries of all ages. If you wish, you may **assist** and **teach** in one of the Vocational/Educational classes.

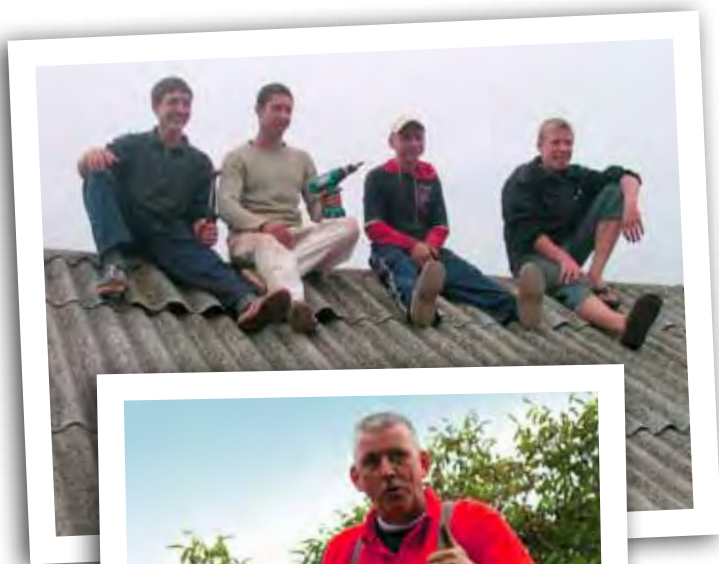
